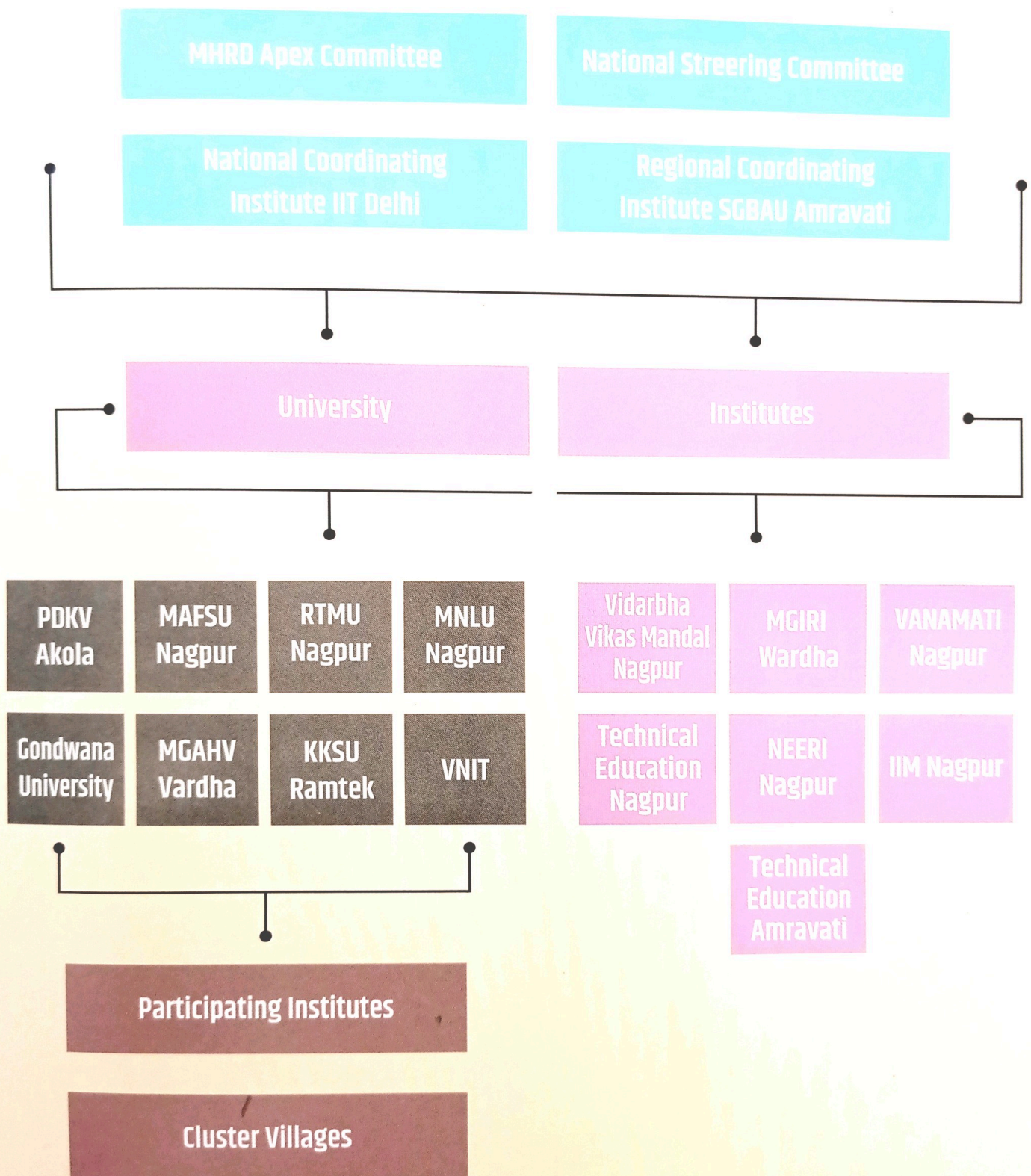
Structural Network of NSC
